Cruise Itineraries

From September to April, we sail from the ports of Punta Arenas, Chile and Ushuaia, Argentina.

Our 4-night one-way itineraries, combinable for 8-night roundtrip cruise itineraries, enter the fjords and narrow channels of Tierra del Fuego, where bigger cruises cannot access. Both sail an exclusive route through hidden bays and virgin forests of Southern Patagonia.

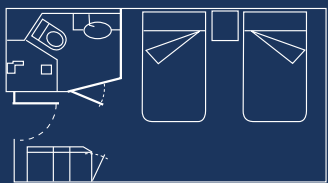

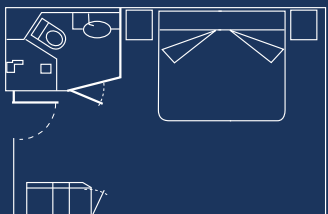
Our Fleet

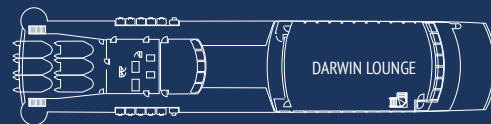


Standard Cabin
177 sq.ft / 16,5 m2

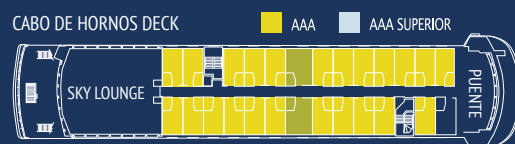


Superior Cabin

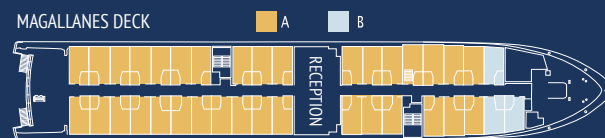

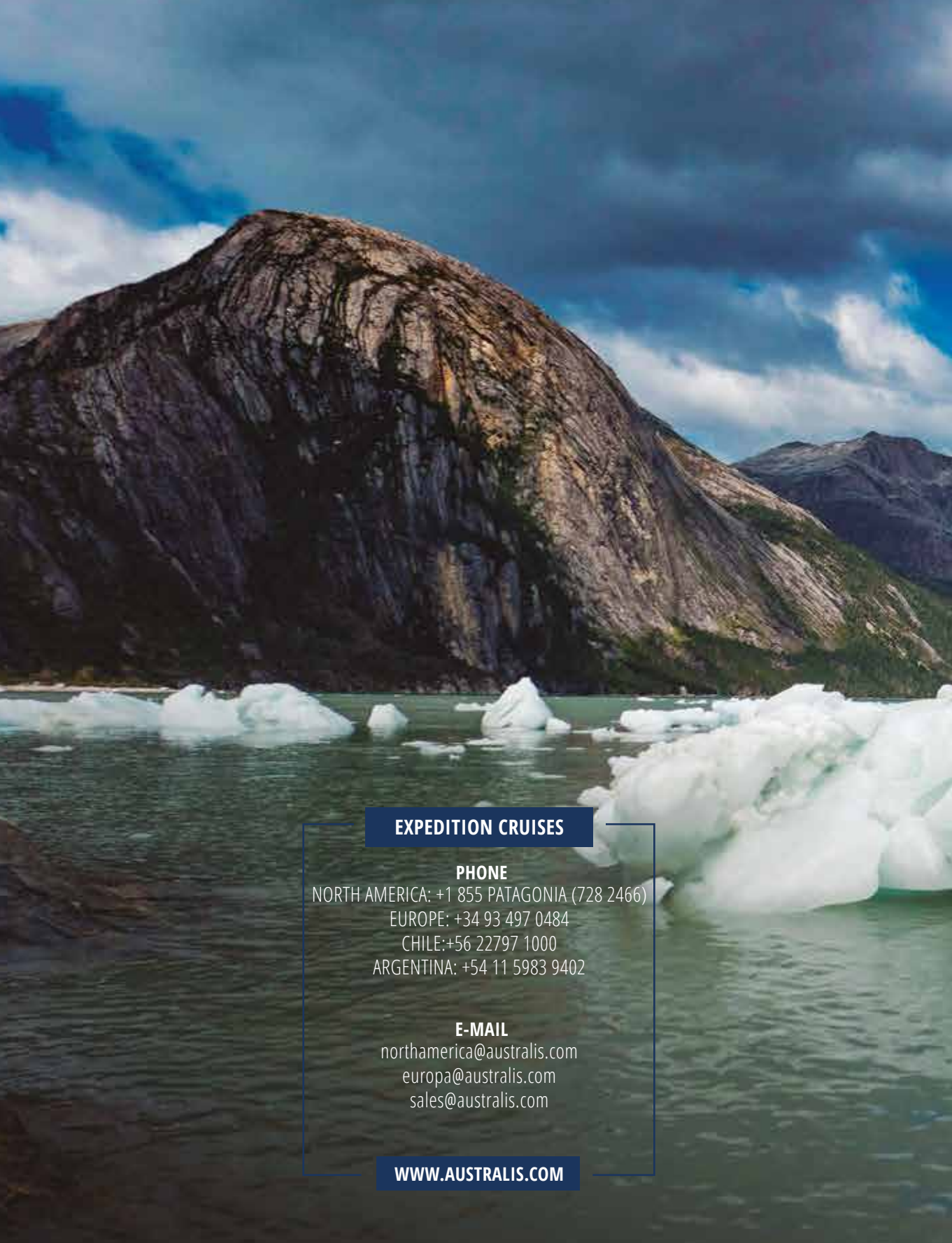
